## Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI & ADA

Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, national origin, or disability in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

To obtain additional information about your rights under Title VI, contact Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin or disability by Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association, you may file a Title VI/ADA complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Discrimination Complaint Form, including Title VI and ADA Compliance.

## How to file a Title VI complaint with Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association:

- 1. To obtain a Vehicle Complaint Form, from Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association, contact Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association, Attention: Transportation Director at 15 Mt. Ebo Rd. South, Brewster, NY 10509. To obtain a Complaint Form relative to a driver, contact Christine Galli, Title VI Coordinator, Human Resources Department, at the same address above.
- 2. In addition to the complaint process at Hudson Valley Cerebral Palsy Association, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region VII, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106.
- 3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
- 4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
